HIGHLIGHTS of Game 02-18: Hart 14 - Valencia 13 (Foothill League)**

G#02-18 Hart wins thriller in 10th inning 14-13 over Valencia (c)
This game had everything you could ask for in a baseball game. The momentum and emotions went back and forth throughout the game.

It was Televised, and will be shown on Wednesday. Be sure to see it and hopefully someone will tape it and send me a copy, I would love to see it again, it was that good, and since Hart finally won it, made it that much better.

The TV people are worried because the game ran almost 4 hours, and they are thinking of breaking it over a 2 day span. We will see.

There was quite a few Hart alumni players and parents who were at the game, to cheer Hart on in what may turn out to be one of the most important games this season.

Valencia was trying to sweep Hart in the 3 games Foothill League series. This was something that had not been done since I have been doing stats starting in 1987. In both of the previous games this year, Hart had good leads, and then stopped scoring. Valencia scored late in the game and won in the last inning.

The game started out with Won Yoo on the mound for Hart, and he seemed to have his stuff, but Jimmy Rohan hit a line single to center, and Matt Aidem was hit by a pitch. Jon Porter then hit a 3 run homer to right center that was hit so far, I thought my car was going to have a broken window when I retrieved it after the game. Score Valencia 3-0.

In the Hart first, with Jared Clark pitching for Valencia. leadoff batter Chris Valaika got one up in the nice breeze blowing out, and it went over the left center field wall for his 5th homer of the season. Score Valencia Score Valencia led 3-1.

Won got Valencia 3 up 3 down in the 2nd, and Hart got things going in their half of the 2nd. Chris Giordano walked, and Chris Steck laid down a perfect bunt and beat it out. Todd Wilson singled to left scoring Giordano from 2nd. John Curtis who has been on fire for the last 5 games then bombed a long 3 run homer to center, his 4th of the season. Hart threatened for more, when Danny Williams doubled, Valaika walked and runners moved to 2nd and 3rd with only 1 out when Jason Brown sacrificed. A strikeout and ground out ended to 2nd. Hart now leading 5-3.

Valencia scored 1 in the 3rd on a single to left by Patrick O'Sullivan, and he took 2nd when the left fielder couldn't come up with the ball cleanly. O'Sullivan scored on a double by Rohan. Score Hart 5-4.

Hart matched the run in their half of the 3rd when Giordano singled to center, and then made it to 3rd when the pitcher threw the ball into the visitors bull pen. Steck grounded to the right side scoring Giordano. Score Hart 6-4.

Valencia picked up another run in the 4th. After an opening strikeout, Yoo hit Brett Erickson with a pitch, and he moved to 3rd when Sammy Tyndall sacrificed him to 2nd and was safe on a bad throw to first by the 3rd baseman, allowing Erickson to take 3rd. After a strikeout for the 2nd out, O'Sullivan then laid down a perfect squeeze bunt scoring Erickson.

Hart again matched the run in their half of the 4th when Valaika walked, took 2nd on a sacrifice by Brown, and scored from 2nd on a single to center by Mike Alvarado. Score Hart 7-4.

Valencia threatened in the 5th when Matt Aidem singled and Clark walked. Porter hit a deep fly to center, moving Aidem to 3rd, but Yoo stopped the potential rally when he struck out Richard Cadena and Erickson.

In the 5th, Garrett Rieck who pitched 1 inning Tuesday and was the winning pitcher in that game, relieved for Valencia and Hart opened its biggest lead. With 1 out Wilson singled to left center and stole 2nd. After 2 out, Wilson scored when Danny Williams singled to left. Score Hart 8-4.

Won Yoo took the mound in the 6th, and immediately got in serious trouble by walking the first 2 batters. A wild pitch then moved the runners to 2nd and 3rd. O'Sullivan hit a grounder to first that was muffed, and the run scored, making it Hart 8-6. Jimmy Rohan then put Valencia ahead 9-8 when he bombed a 3 run homer to center.

Kyle Boggio relieved Yoo, and walked Aidem. Jared Clark then homered to left, and Jon Porter hit his 2nd homer of the game to right, and Valencia quickly led 12-8 with nobody out. Kaulin Boggio came in to relieve his brother, and Valencia with a 4 run lead started using pinch hitters. Kaulin then got the side out 1-2-3.

In the 6th for Hart, Matt Aidem now relieved Rieck who again was now the possible winning pitcher of record. In the 2 previous games, Aidem had completely shut Hart down, striking out all 3 batters he faced in the first meeting, and giving up only a single in the 2nd game, which was immediately wiped out on a game ending double play.

Aidem looked like money in the bank after he gave up a inning opening single to Brown then got a double play on a great fielding gem by the 1st baseman Chris London. Andy Sevanian batting for Craig Cohen then lined out to short, and the inning took only a minute.

Valencia then extended their lead off Kaulin Boggio when Wes Pascolla opened with a flare single to center, and O'Sullivan hit another flare to right. A fielders choice moved Pascolla to 3rd, and he scored on a single to left by Aidem. Score now 13-8, and it looked like Hart was on the verge of being swept by Valencia as they came to bat in the 7th down by 5.

PAGE 4: 04/12/2002 Bottom of 7th. - Game went 10 innings:

In the 7th: Giordano singled and moved to 3rd on a double by Steck. Wilson grounded to short scoring Giordano. Curtis doubled scoring Steck. Williams doubled scoring Curtis. Score now Valencia 13-11. A wild pitch moved Williams to 3rd. Valaika struck out on a pitch in the dirt, and made it to first. Valaika now representing the tying run at first got picked off first, and got in a rundown and Williams scored to make it 13-12, but now there was 2 out and no one on.

Jason Brown walked. With Brown running, Mike Alvarado crashed a long double to right center scoring Brown to TIE THE GAME 13-13. Craig Cohen walked and with Giordano coming up, coach Ozella put some speed on the bases, Paxton Howard at 2nd and J.P. Slauenwhite at 1st. Giordano hit a sharp 1 hopper to short and the 7th inning ended in a 7-7 tie.

Kaulin Boggio went out to pitch the 8th and got Valencia 3 up 3 down with 2 strikeouts. Aidem still pitching for Valencia, gave up 3 singles in the 8th by Wilson, Curtis and Valaika, but he also struck out the side and the game went to the 9th.

Kaulin Boggio took the mound in the 9th and after 1 out gave up a bad bounce single to short by Pascolla, and after a deep fly to center, Rohan hit a sharp single to left, his 4th hit of the game. After pitching an excellent game in relief Kaulin Boggio was relieved by Jeff Icenogle who was on a 5 game losing streak. Jeff got a fly to left to end the top of the 9th inning.

Hart went 3 up 3 down in the 9th, and Icenogle took the mound in the 10th and walked the leadoff batter Clark. Jon Porter who had already hit 2 homers bunted and Icenogle made a great play to get Porter at first, but Clark was now at 2nd. The Iceman then struck out Chris London and pinch hitter Dan Goodman, and Hart came to bat in the bottom of the 10th with Matt Aidem still pitching.

So the game had turned from a slugfest to a pitchers duel.

Chris Steck led off with a nice easy grounder to short, but shortstop O'Sullivan threw the ball away and Steck took 2nd. Todd Wilson who was 4 for 5 up to that point was swinging away and hit the ball off the plate, and although he was out at first, he had moved Steck to 3rd. John Curtis who was 3 for 5 with a homer and a double at that point, was intentionally walked to put runners at first and third with 1 out, and bringing up Danny Williams who was 3 for 5 with 2 doubles at that point.

With the infield in and the outfield playing short to prevent a bloop hit, Williams hit a liner to right that was caught by the right fielder Tyndall, but the throw to the plate was not in time to catch the sliding Steck, and Hart had emerged with a dramatic 14-13 victory on a sacrifice fly.

Hitting stars Chris Steck 2 for 6, 3 runs scored 1 double. Todd Wilson 4 for 6, 2 runs scored, 2 RBI. John Curtis 3 for 5 2 runs scored 4 RBI, 1 double 1 homer. Danny Williams 3 for 5, 3 RBI, including the game winning Sac. Fly. 2 doubles. Mike Alvarado 2 for 6 2 RBI, 1 double. Chris Giordano 2 for 5, 3 runs scored. Chris Valaika 2 for 4, 2 walks, 2 runs scored and a homer. Jason Brown 1 for 3 with a big walk, and sacrifices. Winning Pitcher Jeff Icenogle is now 2-5, Matt Aidem lost his first game of the year.

This was the 4th game of the year Hart has gone into Extra Innings (The Burroughs game went into the 8th before it was called by darkness). In 1990 and 1992 Hart had 3 extra inning games.

Alvarado, Steck and Wilson all had 6 at bats, a record previously shared by seven others.

Jason Brown had 2 sacrifices, a record shared by many.

The team had 45 at bats, breaking the record of 44 set against Valencia on 4-30-96.

Team pitchers recorded 43 at bats breaking the record 41 against West Torrance in a 10 inning Quarter Final Playoff game on 5-30-97, and against Corona Centennial in an 11 inning Quarter Final playoff game on 5-26-2000

Hart pitchers also faced 52 batters breaking the record of 49 also set by the same West Torrance and Corona Centennial teams.

Hart next plays Canyon at Hart on Tuesday 4-16-2002. No doubt we will see Jake Coash. Hope all will be there to cheer Hart on.
