Then after West scored 2 un-earned runs on Hart starter Tyler Eyrich in the 2nd, Hart had one of their biggest innings in a long time when they answered back with 8 runs in the bottom of the 2nd highlighted by a 3 run homer by Bryan Lucas.

Eyrich pitched well but only retired the side in the 1st.

He was the victim of some poor fielding and only 1 of the 4 runs he gave up was earned.

In the 5th Eyrich gave up a dunk single by Aaron DeGuire and then a foul popup by Kyle Petters was dropped giving him a 2nd chance and he promptly lined a sharp single to put 2 runners 1st and 3rd.
