# Second year Foothill League champs.

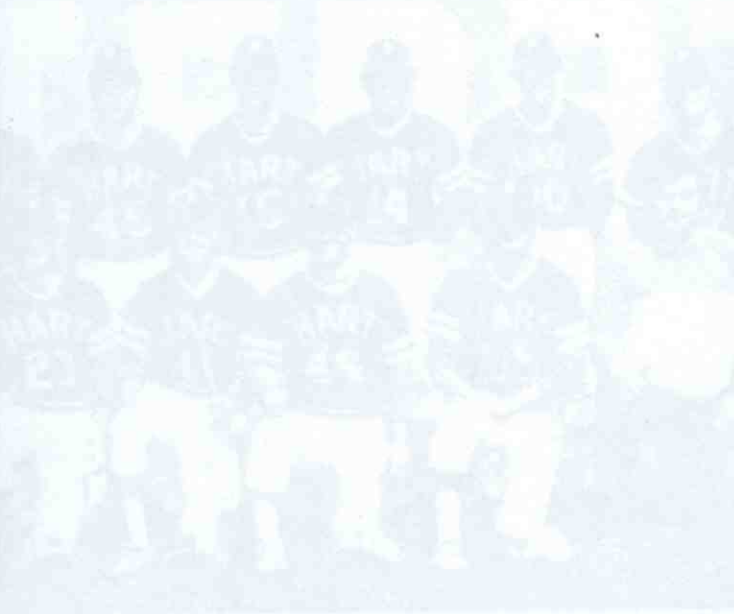
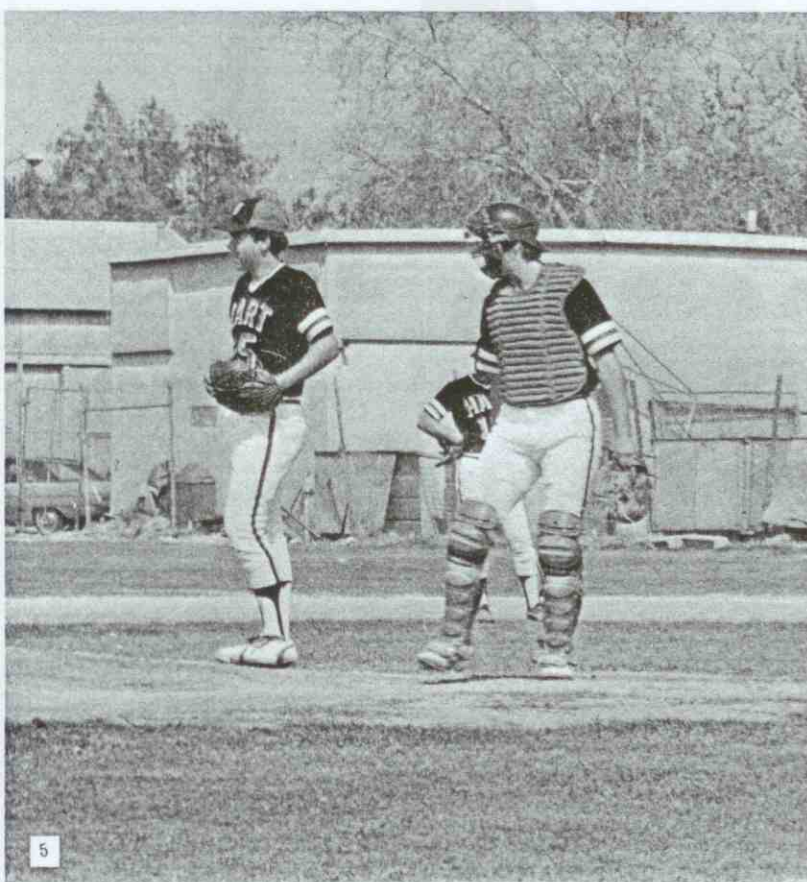
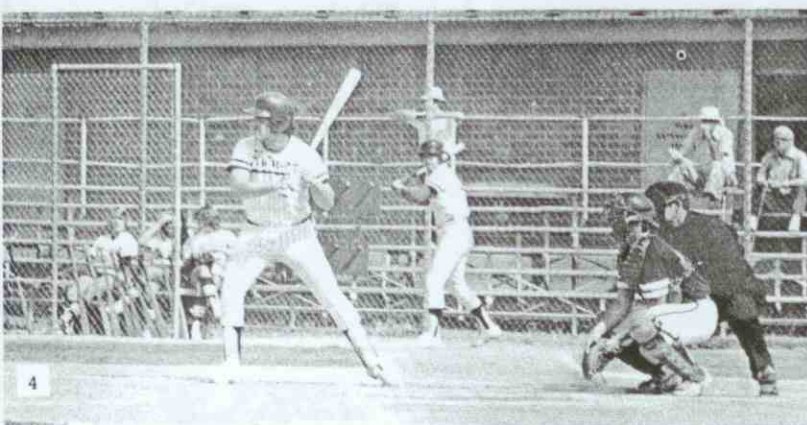
