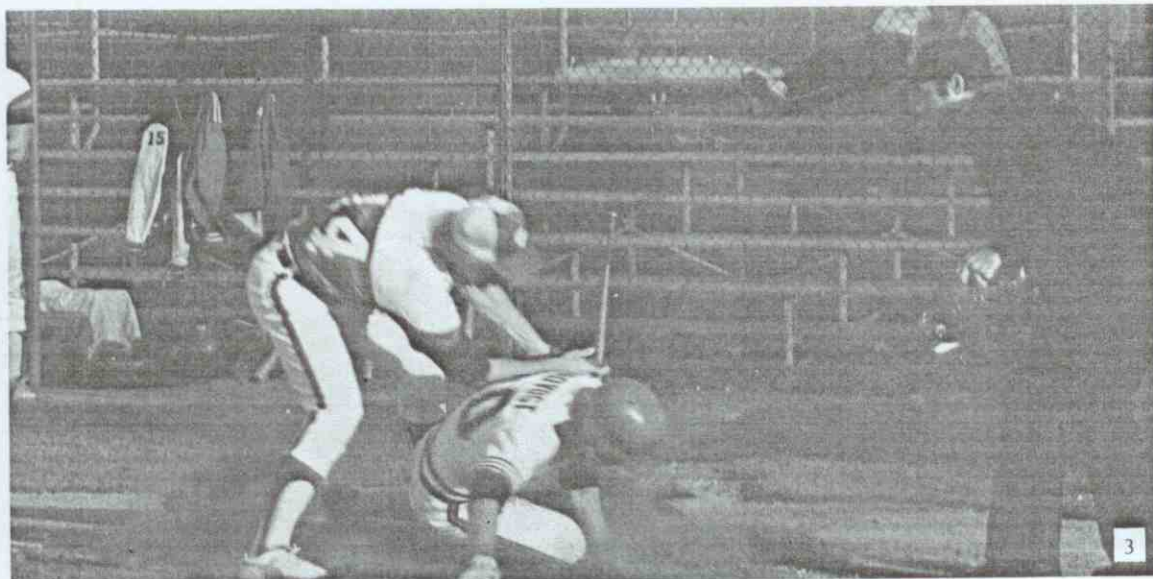

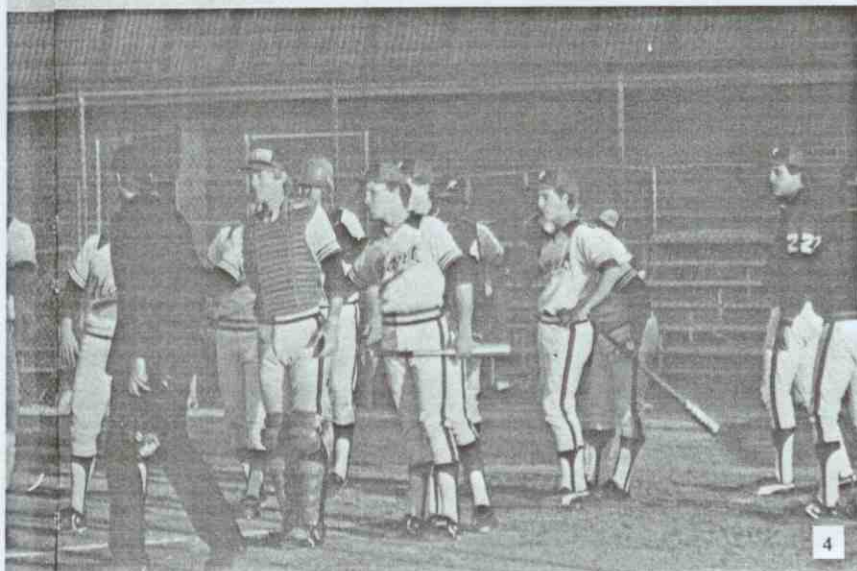
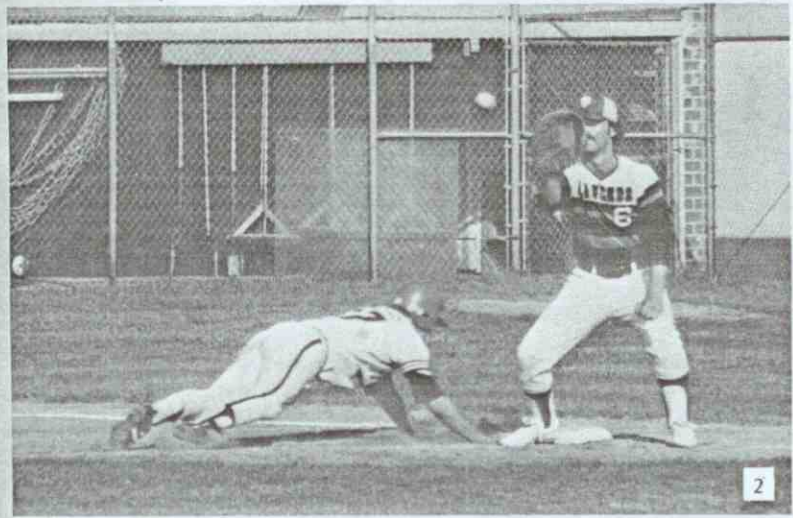


# Sending Up Smoke Signals
